SETTING UP

Enabling Panopto


- Several different tools
 - Course Tool Application – main tool for activating Panopto on site
 - Student Video Submission – enables students to submit videos for assessments
 - Video Button – allows adding videos to content items
 - Video Embed – allows embedding videos in content folders
 - Video Link – allows linking to videos in content folders.

Adding Panopto menu item

Already added to Module sites as 'Panopto Video'

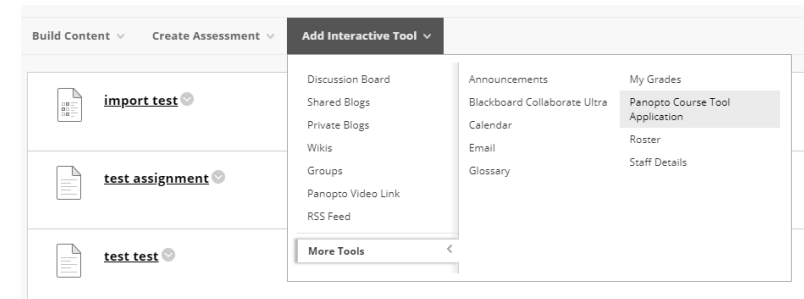
- Add directly as Tool Link

Add Course to Panopto

Creates a Panopto folder for the course and sets up access so that instructors are able to create content in the folder and students are able to view it. Once the course has been added to Panopto you may associate additional Panopto folders to the course.



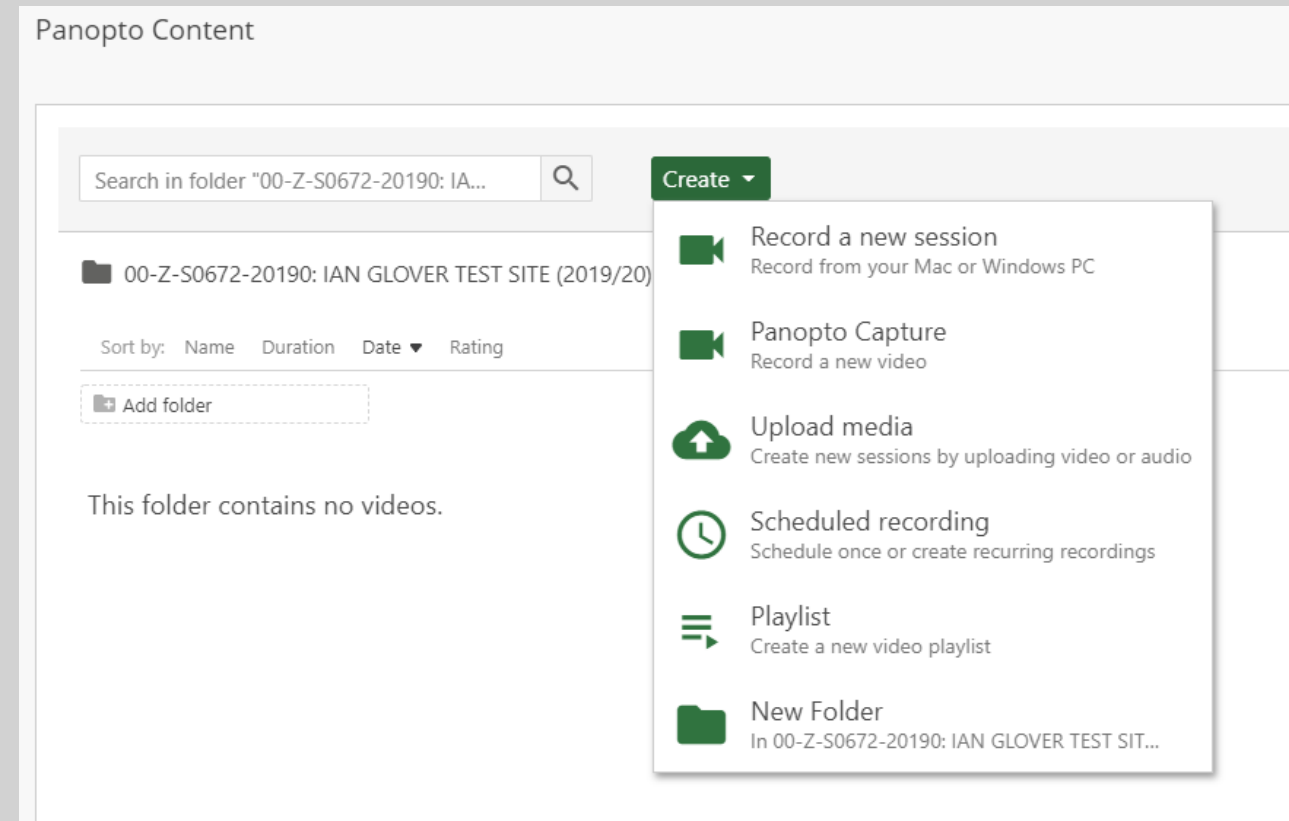
ADDING AND EMBEDDING

Adding Content to Site

- Standard options for adding content
 - Create with Panopto Recorder
 - Create with Panopto Capture
 - Upload existing media
- Note: can also move or copy media in personal folder to module folder

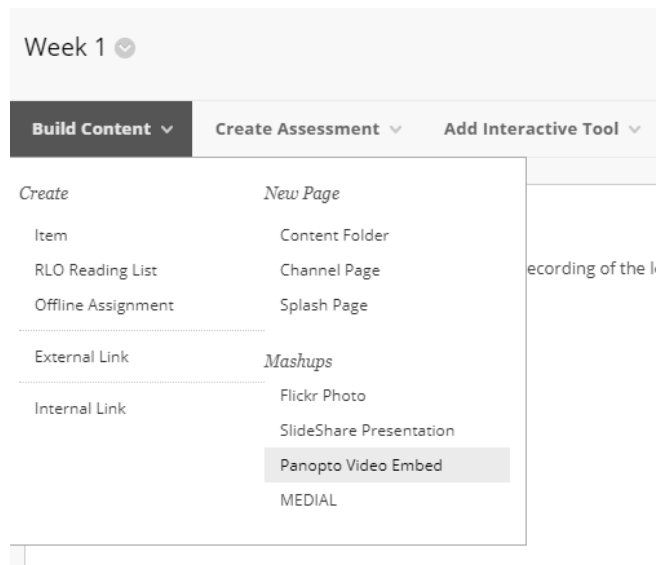


Making Content Available

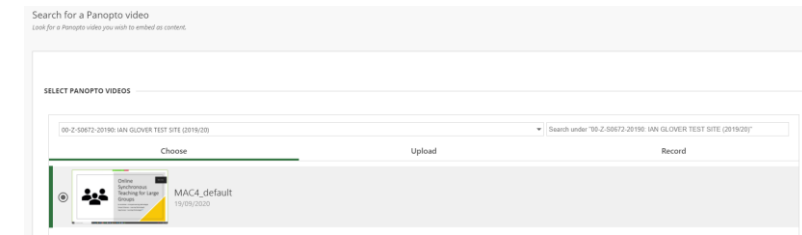
- Four options
 - Make entire Panopto folder available by making link available to students
 - Embed video into content area
 - Add link to content area
 - Embed with other information
- First option easiest, other options more integrated – last one most versatile

Embedding Video in Content Area

- Step 1 - In Content Area
 - Build Content
 - Panopto Video Embed

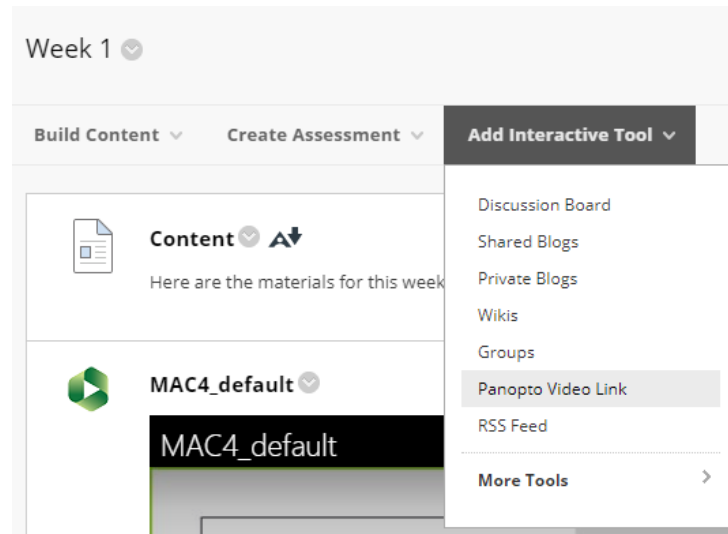


- Step 2 – On Selection Page
 - Choose video already in module folder
 - Upload and embed existing video file
 - Record and embed new video




Adding Link to Content Area

- Step 1 - In Content Area
 - Add Interactive Tool
 - Panopto Video Link




- Step 2 – On Selection Page
 - Select folder
 - Select Video (called 'Lecture' on page)
 - Edit Title and Description (optional)



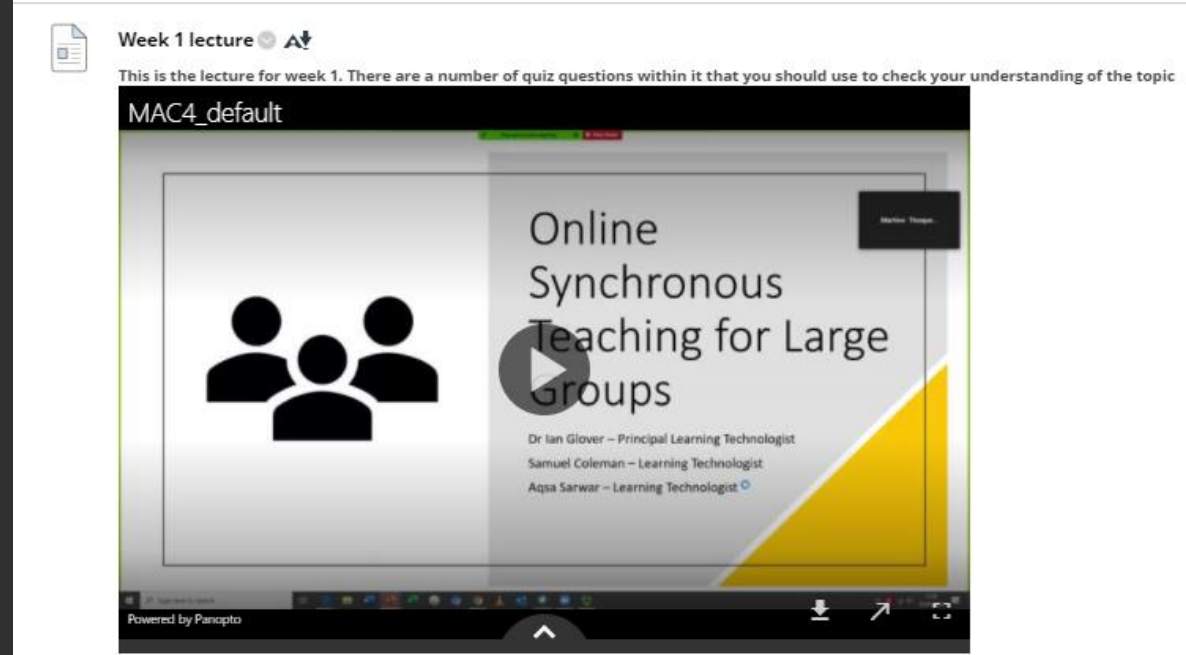
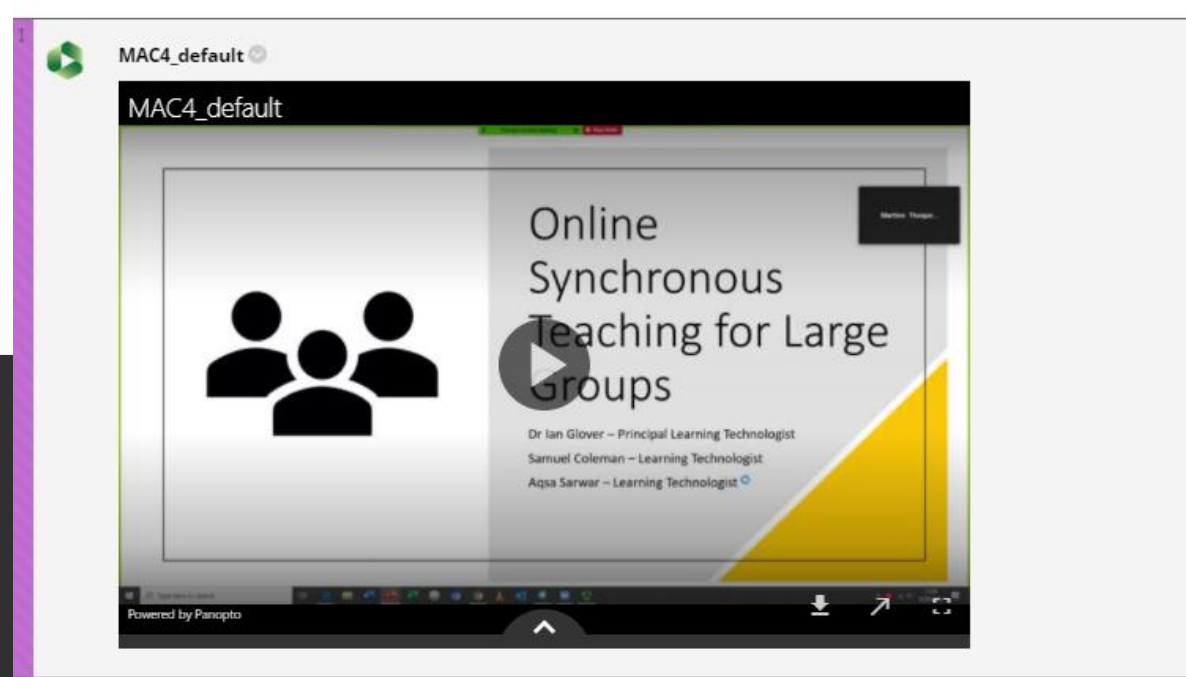

ASSESSMENTS

Student Video Submissions

- Students have a personal folder for their own video uploads
- Can be used for submitting video and audio files for assessment
- Copies the submitted item so no subsequent changes can be made

Adding Submission Instructions

- In Editor:
 - Click Mashups button
 - Panopto Student Video Submission
- Instructions pasted into text area

Panopto assessment ✓

- Step 1:** Record or upload your video in Panopto. To start creating your video, [click here to open your personal folder](#).
- Step 2:** Open the assignment in Blackboard and select **Write Submission**.
- Step 3:** In the text editor, expand **Mashups** and select **Panopto Student Video Submission**.
- Step 4:** A window will open to show the videos in your personal folder. If your video is located in a different folder, select the correct folder from the drop-down at the top.
- Step 5:** Select the video you wish to submit and click **Insert**.
- Step 6:** Your video will be added to the submission. Add any extra information and **Submit**.

Marking

- Assessment submission will include link to video
- Click link to open video in 'full' Panopto view
- Mark as normal
- Video copied, so student won't know video has been accessed

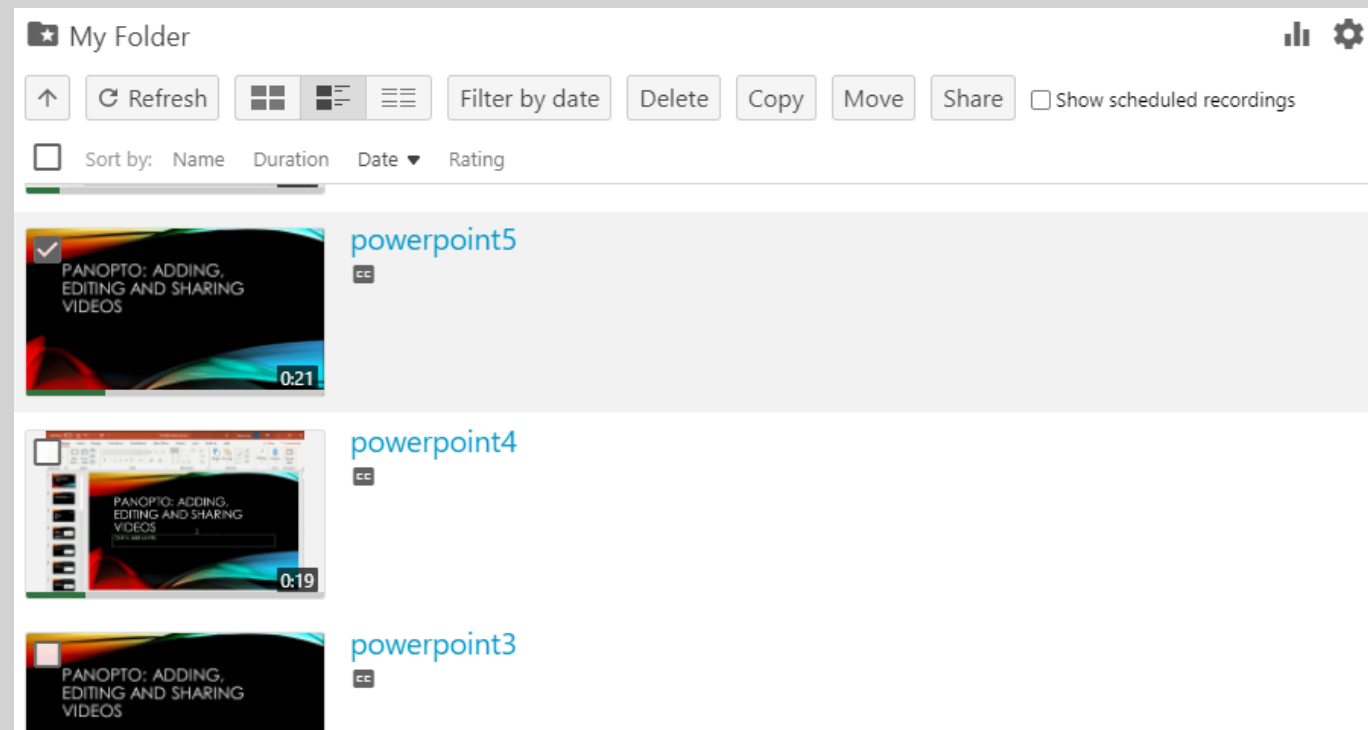

MANAGING MODULE FOLDER

Moving from Personal Folder

- Change to 'My Folder' in drop down and click 'Open Panopto' button
- Tick videos to move and then then 'Move' button
- Select the relevant module folder
 - Shown under first 'Private' list



Manual Release of Videos

- Default: If folder visible to students, then all contents visible
- Can be set to require explicit release to students
 - Open Folder settings
 - Settings menu
 - Availability to 'never'

Releasing Video to Students

- Unreleased videos marked 'Not available to viewers'
- Hover over video and click 'Publish' to release
- 'Unpublishing' can be done through settings menu for video
